**NO SEW / SINGLE (1) layer**  
**Fleece Blankets**

Blanket Making Materials Needed

- Fleece Fabric (only 1 layer)
  - Baby: 1 yard of fabric
  - Child: 1 1/2 yards of fabric
  - Teen: 2 yards of fabric
- Scissors (for each person helping)
- Rotary Cutter
- Cutting Mat
- Ruler or 4" square corner tracers
- Optional: masking tape, chalk

ALL Blanket Sizes Welcome

*\*ALL blankets NEED to be CLEAN,  
FLAT & FREE of Pet Hair, Perfume & Smoke.\**

**STEP 1**

Remove selvages along both edges. This is the factory edge that is thin, curled over and sometimes white. There are two!

Please remove both selvages. They are ugly and your blanket will look better if you remove.

**BONUS;** You can use the leftover selvages to braid and make dog toys.

**STEP 2**

Cut a 4" square from each corner.

**NOTE:** Measure the first corner and then use that corner to measure the other 3.

**STEP 3**

Cut fringe 1" wide 4" deep on all 4 sides.

**NOTE:** Use your thumb as a gauge for the 1" width.

**STEP 4**

TIE each individual fringe in the middle with 1(one) Knot making sure the blanket lays flat when finished.
